- The business name on your business account application must match exactly the IRS letter of issuance of the TIN or EIN (if applicable) and any documentation approved by the state of Utah for the organization for the business.
- At least one owner of the business must be a member of the Credit Union in good standing.
- A completed Business Member Service Agreement Part 1 (or business account application)

Sole Proprietor

- The sole proprietor's social security number, or the TIN/ EIN
- If applicable, any Doing-Business-As (DBA) registrations approved by the State of Utah
- A completed Business Profile
- A completed Business Member Service Agreement Part 1 (or business account application)

General Partnership, Limited Partnership, or Limited Liability Limited Partnership

- The TIN/ EIN assigned by the IRS.
- Partnership Application or Partnership Certificate approved by the State of Utah
- If applicable, any Doing-Business-As (DBA) registrations approved by the State of Utah
- A completed Business Profile

Limited Liability Company

- The TIN/EIN Assigned by the IRS
